Text

Purple - Things written in purple are either placeholders or rough copy that needs your review/attention. When you re-write them, you can change them back to black.

Red - Notes to design team on design needs. Will not appear on the deck itself

Black Highlight - These slide labels help us to understand the main point or intended purpose of a slide. These are just for internal use, and will <u>not</u> appear on the deck itself

Circles

- Red circles mean I/you don't think this slide is needed in final deck
- Orange circle mean I/you think it's unclear if the slide is needed in final deck
- 1 Grey circle with number in it is differentiating different options/ideas for a slide



Opioid Overdoses are a Big Problem

SPOTLIGHT ON FENTANYL:

Problem

- Synthetic opioid
 50 to 100 times
 more powerful
 than morphine.
- Highly potent, so a small amount can rapidly be deadly.
- Nearly impossible to detect because it cannot be smelled or tasted.

OPIOIDS OVERDOSES ARE DEADLY

- **70K+** people died of synthetic opioid overdose in 2021 alone
- Increased 58% since 2017
- Increased **781%** since 1999
- **92%** of drug overdoses are preventable deaths

WE HAVE LIFE SAVING MEDICINE

 Naloxone (also known as Narcan) prevents and reverses the deadly effects of an opioid overdose

but only if it's given in time.

Immediate Danger Requires Immediate Response

How the Device Works

- Smartwatch
 - visualize a large smartwatch (see CAD drawing for ideas)
- Medicine Cartridges
 - visualize several different types of available cartridges



- 1. Fill watch with cartridge of most concern
 - a. ie: when hiking in area with venomous snake
- 2. Vitals tracked constantly
 - *a. ie: the device knows your pulse, oxygen saturation, respiratory rate, EKG, movement, falls, blood pressure with inflatable band option*
- 3. Critical-need detection
 - *a. ie: detected vital sign changes even if you are incapacitated.*
- 4. Medication delivery system
 - a. ie: antidote injected
- 5. Emergency services alert broadcasting
 - a. *ie: GPS coordinates sent and emergency services called*
- 6. Another Saved Life





BUSINESS MODEL OPTIONS:

- 1. Branded cartridges licensing deals or partnerships with drug manufacturers
- 2. Generic cartridges filled at the pharmacy
- 3. User-refillable cartridges

Call Out: FASTER TIME-TO MARKET

Because all drugs are approved and on the market, there are **less strict FDA testing/approvals** required for the cartridges.

- 80,411 opioid overdose deaths in 2021
- 16.95 million doses of naloxone were distributed in the U.S. in 2021.

Epilepsy

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- 3.4 million people have epilepsy
- Roughly 8 Million epipens sold
- each year~\$2.4B in revenues

- 695,000

- 16.3 million Americans aged 20 and older have Coronary heart disease

Anaphylactic Shock

- - allergic reaction

Sepsis

- ~1.7 million adults in the U.S. develop sepsis
- ~270,000 die as a result.
- 3rd leading cause of death in US hospitals

Plus, Potential Battlefield Applications

- Antidote from nerve gas
- The general can remotely administer to soldiers from headquarters
- Need to stay awake for days on a mission
- To stay up they need XXX drugs
- Device could monitor their vitals and provide the right dose at the right time
- Morphine as long been used by the military for pain relief and shock prevention, Narcan for morphine overdose
- If the medic is too far away the device could administer at the right time, giving the soldier enough time to apply a life saving tourniquet, etc.
